

Crossrail - Paddington Station

A 'Crossrail' compliant product development for a new railway infrastructure



The Crossrail network project has given London and the South East a new railway improving journey times across London, to easing congestion and offering better connections, the Elizabeth line will provide easier, quicker and more direct travel opportunities across the capital.

The iconic Paddington Station is a Central London railway terminus and London Underground station complex, located in the Paddington area. The site has been the London terminus of services provided by the Great Western Railway and its successors since 1838.

Quartz worked to the specifications of 'Crossrail' to develop new ducted and perimeter wall-mounted ranges of product, removing plastic components such as drain points and grilles to implementing LSZH (Low smoke zero halogen) cabling throughout, a high specification insulation and the exposed units having a Axalta corrosion proof finish, just to cover a few of the design changes our dedication design team were involved in.

From the Crossrail compliant product to carriage, delivery through the centre of London to this project is only carried out by authorised carriers, with extra emphasis on protecting the many cyclists in the capital but as a whole for raising the safety requirements.
